**ALTERNATE ROUTE:**

Long Path End to Enders may use either the original route listed above or the alternate route listed below. The alternate route uses the Appalachian Trail from its intersection with the Long Path in Harriman Park (Section 6, mile 3.6). Take the AT south for just over 50 miles to link up with the Shawangunk Ridge Trail at High Point State Park, NJ (Section G1 through G2). Then hikers should resume the original route near Greenville (Section 11). The alternate route is longer but has less road walking.
